

## The Orton-Gillingham Teacher Training Program Karachi-Pakistan



The Orton-Gillingham Teacher course is a uniquely designed tool of intervention to treat individuals with dyslexia and language based difficulties. The course gives trainees an understanding of the structure of English Language, an appreciation of the problem of dyslexia/language based difficulties and the principles, rationale and procedures of the Orton-Gillingham multisensory approach.

### The course includes:
