



The Orton-Gillingham Teacher Training Program

The Orton-Gillingham Teacher course is a uniquely designed tool of intervention to treat individuals with dyslexia and language based difficulties. The course gives trainees an understanding of the structure of English Language, an appreciation of the problem of dyslexia/language based difficulties and the principles, rationale and procedures of the Orton-Gillingham multi sensory approach.

The course includes: : 60 Hours of Theory (AOGPE/ USA Certification)
40 Hours of Curriculum Training (CARE Certification)
100 Hours of Practicum with 10 Hours of Supervised Observation
60 Hours of Course work (AOGPE Certification)
